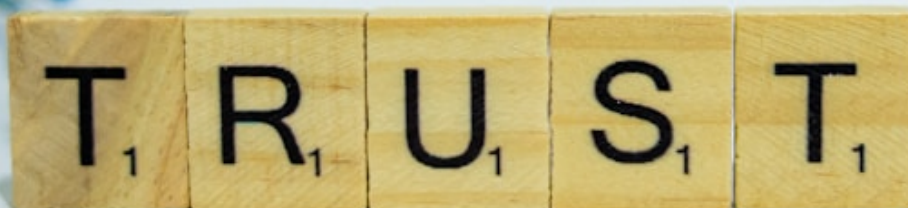
The Milestones: Markers of God's Faithfulness

Jehovah Jireh – God Will Provide

- **Scripture:** *“And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovah Jireh: as it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.”*
(Genesis 22:14, KJV)
- **Devotional Thought:** God provides not only resources, but revelation. Abraham’s altar became a prophecy pointing to Christ—the ultimate provision. In seasons of lack, we anchor in this truth: His provision often meets us at the place of obedience.
- **Prayer:** *Lord, open my eyes to see that You are my Provider, even before the need arises.*

My Job is to Trust – Resting in His Plan

- **Scripture:** *“Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.”* (Proverbs 3:5, KJV)
- **Devotional Thought:** Trust isn’t passive—it’s active surrender. Our only job is to trust; God’s job is to direct.
- **Prayer:** *Father, silence my doubts and strengthen my faith to follow Your lead without hesitation.*

- **Scripture:** *“O LORD, thou hast searched me, and known me.”*
(Psalm 139:1, KJV)
- **Devotional Thought:** God knows us deeper than we know ourselves. His knowledge isn't condemnation; it's covenant care.
- **Prayer:** *Search me, Lord, and shape what You already see into who You've called me to be.*

The Message: Living by the Word

Shape My Heart

from the Inside
Out

- **Scripture:** *“Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me.”*
(Psalm 51:10, KJV)
- **Devotional Thought:**
True transformation begins inward. God reshapes our hearts before He reshapes our circumstances.
- **Prayer:** *Lord, mold me to reflect Christ, from motives to actions.*

The Way We Love – Christlike Compassion

- **Scripture:** *“By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.”* (John 13:35, KJV)
- **Devotional Thought:** Love is the gospel in action. The way we love is the loudest sermon we’ll ever preach.
- **Prayer:** *Jesus, teach me to love beyond convenience, beyond comfort, beyond self.*

You First – Prioritizing God Above All

- **Scripture:** *“But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”* (Matthew 6:33, KJV)
- **Devotional Thought:** When God is first, everything else finds its order.
- **Prayer:** *Lord, dethrone my idols and take Your rightful place in my life.*



What You Focus On – Fixing Our Eyes on Jesus

- **Scripture:** *“Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith...”* (Hebrews 12:2, KJV)
- **Devotional Thought:** Focus fuels faith. Whatever we magnify grows larger in our spirit.
- **Prayer:** *Father, redirect my focus to Your Son, not my storms.*

The Ministry: Walking in Purpose

Nothing Outside of You – Anchored in Christ Alone

- **Scripture:** *“For in him we live, and move, and have our being.”* (Acts 17:28, KJV)
- **Devotional Thought:** Without Him, nothing stands. With Him, nothing fails.
- **Prayer:** *Jesus, let everything in me testify that my life is hidden in You.*



Only One Way – The Exclusive Truth of the Gospel

- **Scripture:** *“I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.”* (John 14:6, KJV)
- **Devotional Thought:** In a world of many paths, only one way leads home—Jesus.
- **Prayer:** *Lord, keep me on the narrow way, regardless of how wide the world’s road may look.*

When I Don't Feel God – Trusting Beyond Emotions

- **Scripture:** *“For we walk by faith, not by sight.”* (2 Corinthians 5:7, KJV)
- **Devotional Thought:** God’s presence isn’t proven by our feelings but by His faithfulness. Silence doesn’t mean absence.
- **Prayer:** *Father, steady my faith when my emotions waver.*

Still Chosen – Identity and Calling in Christ

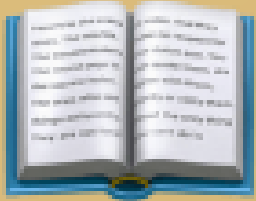
- **Scripture:** *“Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you...”*

- **Devotional Thought:** God’s choice overrides rejection, failure, and shame. We are still chosen, still called, still His.
- **Prayer:** *Lord, anchor me in my identity as Your chosen vessel.*
